


# 2 Year Nursery Learning Leaflet

## Autumn 1st Half Term 2017

In Early Years our learning can look a bit different! We learn through a mix of carefully set up play base opportunities and through more formal class based learning.

<p>Within the nursery we will focus on a different story each week. Over the week we will listen to the story several times, act it out and begin to join in with various phases through the books. Some stories also will be read with puppets and props. We will be using the floor outside and the large board to make large marks with pens and chalks and practising drawing lines and circles</p>	<p>We will be introducing both number and shapes during this half term. We will be joining in with lots of counting songs and rhymes and will also be counting objects. As an introduction to shapes we will be building with a variety of different shaped and sized bricks and making arrangements with shapes. We will also be sorting objects into separate categories and completing puzzles together.</p>	<p>In Personal, Social &amp; Emotional Development we will be concentrating on developing confidence and building relationships with both adults and other children within the room. We will be playing turn taking games, spending time getting to know our key person and key group friends and will be becoming familiar with our daily nursery routine.</p>	<p>In physical development we will be spending lots of time developing our large muscle movements. We will be taking part in activities such as climbing, kicking and throwing balls, washing windows and dancing with ribbons. These activities will help with both our balance and developing our arm muscles ready for us to start making smaller marks on paper.</p>	<p>Within the two year nursery there is also a strong focus on communication. During everyday activities and interaction with your child there will be lots of commenting on what they are doing and simple questioning. There will be lots of time and opportunities to encourage and support the children to talk, ask and answer questions.</p>
