

Year 6 - Autumn 1

Maths: In maths we will begin by understanding place value of numbers including multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000. We will build our resilience through exploring and solving a range of mathematical investigations relating to place value.



Guided reading: The children will be looking at the text 'Skellig'. We will focus on vocabulary, summarising, inference and questioning skills.



English: During this term, the children will be creating their own Poems based on the poem 'If'. We will then be looking at a narrative 'When a Monster Calls'. We will be using Jane Considine (The Write Stuff).



Science: The children will explore the process of classification in some detail and how it differs from, but relates to, the identification of living things



Homelearning: Every Friday, the children will bring home some home learning. They will need to bring it in the following week.

PE: will be on a Tuesday and a Friday, please wear PE kit to school

Music: 6LH will have a weekly music lesson with Mrs Devonport on a Tuesday. 6CO will have swimming.

Art: This half term our art unit is 'Craft and design: Photo opportunity'. We will improve our mastery of art by using cameras to take photos, editing them using photo editing apps and drawing and painting a picture based on our own selfies.



Geography: This half term we will be focused on Britain's National Parks, this will include a visit to Dartmoor to explore the landscape. We will also spend time promoting protecting these important geographical landscapes.



Computing: Children will learn about the history of computers and how they have changed over time. They will learn about debugging, to make a programme more reliable.

PSHE: Children will focus on what makes a family and respecting others differences

RE: The children will learn about religious and non-religious worldviews and about caring for the Earth.
