

## Year 1/2 Spring 2- 2026



**Science** - In our Year 1 science unit on materials, we will learn that objects are things they can see or touch. We will explore how the same object can be made from different materials and discover that many everyday items are made from more than one material. We will also investigate the properties of materials, and think about why certain materials are chosen for particular purposes. This helps us understand how materials are used in the world around us.

**RE** - In RE we will be exploring the question 'Who do Christians believe made the world?'. .

**DT**- In DT this half term we will be learning about structures and what a structure needs to stay up. We will be carefully planning to build our own windmills and considering what would need to make this successful!



**English** - During this half term we will be exploring 6 different books. We will be diving deeper into these books and focusing on the fantastic vocabulary within them. We will be focusing on writing a sentence that includes a capital letter, finger space and full stop as well as beginning to use the word 'and' to join two sentences.



**Geography**- In our Year 1 Geography unit on Food, we will explore where some of our everyday foods come from and how they get from farms to our plates. We will learn about different types of farms, the journey food takes, and simple maps to show where in the world certain foods are grown. This unit helps us understand that food comes from both the UK and other countries, and encourages curiosity about the world around them.

**PSHE**- In PSHE, children will learn about what it means to be part of a community, how to be a good friend, and why rules help us stay safe and happy. They will explore ways to show kindness, take turns, and share, as well as recognise the roles of people who help us in school and the wider community. This unit supports children in understanding how their actions affect others and how everyone can contribute positively to their class and school.

**Maths** - During Spring 2 we will begin to explore addition and subtraction within 20 and then begin to move onto place value within 50. We have been getting used to using a variety of resources such as dienes, rekenreks and tens frames which we will continue to develop.

**Computing** - This half term is focused entirely on improving mouse skills. We will be using laptops to learn how to log on, how to stay safe on a computer and how to improve our mouse skills!

**PE** - will be every Tuesday and Thursday for Squirrels. Please can children wear PE kit into school on these days.

**Music** - The children will be continuing to explore music from around the world in song, instruments and stories. Parents will be invited to come to hear our performance in March.

**Read Write Inc** - The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.
