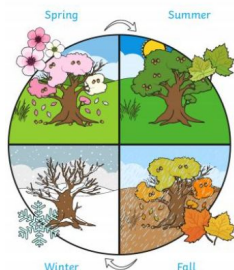


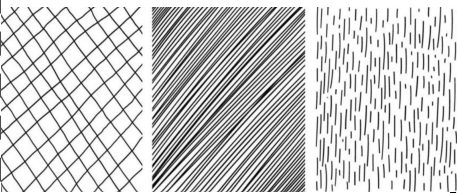
Squirrels - Autumn 1

Science - Our science topic is going to be all about seasons and how our environment changes over the seasons. We will look specifically at the types of animals we see in the seasons and we will observe how the leaves change.

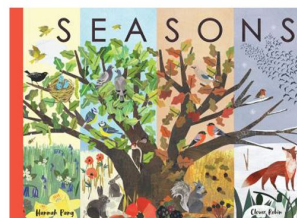


RE - Our key question next half term is "Who do Christians say made the world?".

Art- We will explore line and texture. We will look at how to create different lines using different types of tools and then create our very own self-portraits using these skills.



English - Over the first half term we are going to be exploring one fiction book and one non-fiction book. Our first book is Grandad's island. We will be focusing on oral storytelling and exploring the characters in the story. We will practice forming simple sentences using capital letters and full stops.



In the second half of this term we will be looking at a non-fiction text about seasons which will link with our science topic.

Geography- We are going to look at our local geography and what is in my immediate environment such as our classroom, our school and our local area. We will use simple maps to follow routes.

History- Our focus this half term is past and present and we will study a timeline of events. We will focus on how we have changed over time from being a baby to now.

PSHE- My Healthy self is our unit this half term where we will understand how to look after ourselves and our emotions. We will be able to name the six basic emotions and understand how to recognise when we are feeling that way. We will also consider what activities make us feel calm and what we can do to help with this. finally , we will talk about our trusted adults and who we would approach for support.

Maths - In maths this half term we will be focusing on numbers 10 our number bonds. We will be looking at how we make 10 working with lots of different manipulatives. We will explore tens frames and ensuring that we can count accurately.

Computing - In computing we will be thinking about programming and understanding how important giving instructions are to tell the computer how to do something.

PE - will be every Tuesday and Friday so please ensure all children come into school wearing their PE kit on these days.

Music - This half term the children will continue to develop their music skills through singing and instruments.

Read Write Inc - The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home. Book change day will be every Friday but we would like children to bring their books in daily for 1:1 reading opportunities.
