

Year 3 - Autumn 1

Maths: This term we will be exploring Place Value as well as Addition and subtraction. The children will be building on their previous knowledge and start to look at numbers in the 1,000s. Children will represent, and problem solve using larger quantities.

My Maths homework is assigned to the children every two weeks.



Computing:

The children will be introduced to the concept of networks, learning how devices communicate. From identifying components, learning how information is shared and deepening their understanding by exploring examples of real-world networks.



English:

We will be looking at two texts in English this half term. Our first text will be 'The True story of the 3 little pigs'. Which a narrative Traditional Tale with a Twist.



Our second text 'Stone Age Boy' which is also a narrative will transport the children back in time to the Stone Age.

Science: Our science unit is called rocks, soils and fossils. We will be learning about the different properties of rocks and will be using our observational skills to identify different type of rocks. We will also be looking at soil and how there are different types of soils. Finally, we will be exploring fossils.



P.E:

French:



This half term, children will learn French through greetings and simple conversations. They will greet others, introduce themselves, ask how they are feeling and practise accurate pronunciation and key French sounds.



Art and Design:

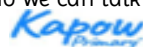
In Art and Design we will be developing our drawing skills. We will be exploring the impact of shading. Children will develop this skill through observational drawings.



Geography: This term we will explore Florida, the 'Sunshine State', and its place within North America. We will learn about its physical and human features, including its climate, tourism, peninsulas and natural hazards such as hurricanes. We will also investigate the importance of space exploration at the Kennedy Space Centre and the need to protect endangered sea turtles and the Everglades. Throughout the unit, we will develop our map skills and compare Florida with the UK.



PSHE: This term we will learn how our minds and bodies are connected and how our emotions can affect how we feel, think and behave. We will explore how to recognise different emotions in ourselves and others, as well as ways to manage strong or difficult feelings. We will also learn about the importance of sleep and healthy habits for looking after our mental and physical health. Finally, we will understand when we may need support and who we can talk to when we need help.



R.E: This half term we will be answering the question 'What does it mean to be a Hindu in Britain today?' In this unit, students explore the Hindu belief in Brahman and how it is expressed in daily life. They will learn about Puja at home, worship in the mandir, and the celebration of Diwali. Students will also reflect on the concept of dharma through two Hindu stories.
