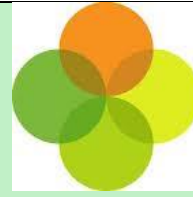


Year 5 Summer 1

<p>Maths: We will be starting this half term by looking at the properties of shapes and learning how to measure angles with a protractor. We will then move on to looking at Geometry – Position and direction.</p>	<p>Guided Reading: We will be reading the firework maker’s daughter by Phillip Pullman. This book is a great read where the children will explore themes such as courage, determination and challenging stereotypes. The children will continue to use key reading skills such as clarification, summarising and predicting to take their understanding further.</p>		<p>English: We will be starting the half term with a narrative text called Cosmic Science. This focuses on a young boy who faces some challenges such as being mistaken for an adult! This book will help us to write our own narrative with a key character.</p>	
<p>Science: This half term, our focus will be on sound. The children will learn about pitch and what affects this in an instrument. We will also investigate how sound travels and reaches our ear.</p>	<p>PE: This half term we will be looking at athletics, where we will be looking at different techniques of running as well as looking at other elements of athletics such as throwing, jumping and much more.</p>	<p>Music: This term in music we will be exploring the Blues, looking to learn more about the piano keyboard and some music notation. We will also use YUMU our online Charanga music platform.</p>	<p>DT: Next half term, children will be learning about how everyday electrical products are designed and used. Our focus will be on torches — exploring how they work, what makes them effective, and how designers create products for specific users</p>	
<p>Geography: This half term we will be developing our understanding and concept of the world’s climate and weather.</p>	<p>Computing: This half term we will be discussing how reliable information is on the internet and how to search safely over different platforms. We will explore how advertisements work and how to identify facts, opinions and beliefs. We will learn what a bot is and how technology can be a positive or negative distraction.</p>	<p>RE: We will be exploring Christianity through the Holy Trinity and believe that God is the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. We will also understand the significance of baptism in welcoming people to the Christian faith.</p>		<p>French: We will be learning the different words for clothing items and how to describe getting dressed in French.</p>
