

# Year 6 – Summer 2

## Maths:

Pupils will complete a range of mathematics projects where they are able to use their new knowledge and skills in a range of real-life contexts. They will look at what it takes to run a business and explore managing finances as an adult.

## Religious Education:

We will be looking at what it means to be a Muslim in Britain today.

**Guided Reading:** This half term we will continue focusing on the text 'The Girl of Ink and Stars.'



**Geography:** In geography, we will be answering our key question 'What makes fair trade fair?' It helps students understand how trade works and why fairness matters in the global economy.

**PSHE – Pupils will look at the risks involved with drugs and alcohol. They will also build on Year 5, where they started to understand how the body changes during puberty and the biology of conception.**

**ART:** We will be exploring sculpture and 3D and creating our very own memory boxes



**Music:** The children will have a weekly music lesson with Mrs Devonport, on a Monday.

**PE:** Will be on a **Monday and Thursday.** Please can children wear a PE kit on these days.

**Computing: Online Safety**

**English:** We will be looking at features of a narrative using the model text 'The Journey', a story about surviving a war. We will then be looking at 'Letters from a light house' and will be writing a recount.
