## **Year 1 Autumn 1 - 2025**


Science - During the Autumn term the children learn about the different seasons.. They will understand which months are in each season and what we notice in nature during these seasons. The children will also be exploring how the seasons affect them - from the clothes they need to wear, to the activities they can play and the places they can go.



Art - During this half term the children will use drawing to develop and share their ideas, experiences and imagination They will develop a wide range of art techniques in using pattern, texture, line and shape They will also know that drawing materials can be used to show light and dark.

**English** - During the term the children will begin by learning about Trains and the exciting journey you can go on with a train. The noises a train makes, the speed, the amount of people and the views you can have on a train.

Then we will be looking at the poetry book - Fireworks - were we will explore describing words for the sounds and effects fireworks have. This will lead to the children writing their own poems and some art work to go with it.





**Maths** - We will be using the White Rose scheme of work, to teach the children about number and place value. We will be using a variety of practical resources to help with our learning.







**Computing -** The children will be learning about the different parts of a computer, from mouse to keyboard.

**PE -** will be every Tuesday and Thursday.. Please can you ensure your child wears a PE Kit to school on those days. This half term the children will be doing rugby and dance.

## History -

During this term, the children will begin to look at Toys and how toys have changed over time. We will be having a special visitor to come in and talk about toys from their childhood and we will compare toys to now. Looking at how technology has changed - making thing smaller - and discussing which toys we prefer, which toys last longer, which toys require batteries or Wifi and which toys can be played without the need for a plug or batteries.

**PSHE** - Learning that families are composed of different people who offer each other care and support. Learning how other people show their feelings and how to respond to them. Looking at conventions of manners and developing an understanding of self-respect.

Music - In our weekly sessions the children will be learning about tempo, dynamics and timbre to create a Western Africa 'call and

response song' inspired by animals..



Read Write Inc - The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.
