


# Year 3 Learning Leaflet

<p>In English the children will be exploring stories with issues and dilemmas. We will be taking part in discussions about the impact of our decisions. To continue with our 'All About Me' theme, we will be looking at biographies and autobiographies.</p>	<p>In Maths the children will be learning how to develop our understanding of place value and will be exploring new written methods for the four calculations. We will learn about our school values, British values and learning powers and how we can incorporate these into our everyday lives. They will be exploring the work of the artist, Picasso</p>	<p>Our unit is animals and humans. We will be learning about the importance of our skeleton and muscles and exploring which animals are vertebrates and invertebrates. We will be discussing healthy eating and why this is important in our lives.</p>	<p>We will be looking to dodge, sprint and dart as we play handball outside, whilst jumping, balancing and sequencing inside in gymnastics. We will learn the importance of teamwork in being successful.</p>	<p>The children will be looking at how to search the internet safely and successfully.
