


Year 4 Learning Leaflet

| <p>In English the children will be focusing on autobiographies by writing about themselves. They will also be exploring stories with issues and dilemmas thinking about the impact of our decisions and actions. To conclude this theme we will be writing diary entries too.</p> | <p>In Maths the children will be learning how to develop our understanding of place value and will be exploring new written methods for the four calculations. They will be given opportunities to apply these skills throughout the maths lessons and across the curriculum.</p> | <p>We will work together to write our class charter and explore our personal strengths, interests and ambitions. We will be focusing on inspirational people in R.E and the world around us in PSHE.</p> | <p>We will be exploring our aspirations for when we are older. We will be exploring the work of the artist, Picasso and then creating 3D masks to go along side this. We will also be comparing the differences between childhoods now and in the past.</p> | <p>We will be learning about Living Things in Science this half term. We will be exploring different habitats, food chains and minibeasts. We will be linking this to our theme as well to see if we can create our own food chain.</p> | <p>We will be developing our attacking and defending skills whilst playing handball outside. Inside, we will be jumping, balancing and sequencing movements in gymnastics. We will learn the importance of teamwork in being successful.</p> | <p>We will start the term focusing on 'Rings of Responsibility' in our E-Safety session. We will move onto learning the basic principles and techniques of simple animation.</p> |
