Children will begin by writing a letter to their future selves before looking at poetry all about them. This will be followed by a diary entry about what future Britain will be like and end with a design and report about their ideal home of the future. The children will be learning about our school values, British values and learning all about Britain. They will learn about how the UK has changed over time and how it continues to change. They will also take part in a range of team activities to understand the value of teamwork.	The children will be exploring Christian and Buddhist beliefs and how these can be expressed through art, drama and music. They will explore what inspires people and reflect on what inspires them in their lives.	We will be looking to dodge, sprint and dart as we play handball outside, whilst jumping, balancing and sequencing inside in gymnastics. We will learn the importance of teamwork in being successful.	Learning how to best search the internet. We will use boolean search codes to narrow and expand searches on google.
