ART

Create your very own beach scene seaside poster in the style of Devon artist Becky Bettsworth. You can choose your favourite beach that you visit. Be ready to tell us a little about it and why it is your favourite.



D & T

Design your own holiday brochure. Pick your favourite holiday destination or research one that you would like to go to. Include pictures of the area, places to stay, fun things to do. What language is spoken and what money is used? Include as much information as you can.



Creative writing

Write a recount about your favourite holiday. Who were you with, where did you go, what adventures did you have? Or... you can write an adventure story about a holiday that you would really like to go on. Who would you go with, what amazing things would you do, what exciting places would you visit? Don't forget to make your writing is as creative and descriptive as you can. Use all of that lovely language and grammar that you have been learning, and be sure to use your very best handwriting. We can't wait to read your stories and display them in the classroom. Happy writing!

PE

Can you create a fitness plan for someone who doesn't exercise regular and has an unhealthy diet? Think of different exercises that you can incorporate to strengthen different muscles. Perhaps it could include a range of yoga, gym, running, sport and resting activities. Think about what makes a balanced diet (and lifestyle).

Write your fitness plan as though it will be going in a fitness magazine.

Maths

Create a maths multiplication game that practices all of your maths fact x tables from 2 to 12. Make sure that the game has rules and clear directions on how to play it. Make sure it has a theme and a title. You can create a board game, card game, powerpoint game or shoebox game. It needs to be colourful and fun to play.
