This area of Learning covers both writing and reading. We will be starting our phonics this term where we will learn how to read and write a sound a day! This term we will also be learning to write the initial sounds of words and some of us will be learning how to write CVC words such as mat, sat, dog. We will also be practising how to write our names.

Maths



In Maths we will be learning numbers 0-5! We will be using Numberblocks to support our learning of these numbers. The children will be exploring different representations of the numbers i.e. tens frame, dice, day-to-day objects. We will be practising and consolidating skills such as 1:1 counting and recognising small groups of objects without needing to count them.

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

We will be learning our school rules and encouraging the children to think about how they can be a good friend.

We will be focussing on sharing and will use sharing timers to help us.

We will also be learning about our school values and the learning animals. We will be introducing Babu who represents respect.



Physical Development



This term we will be exploring different ways of moving! We will also be having P.E sessions with Mr Blacker and Mr Saunders to help further our skills with throwing and catching and negotiating space.
