Essential Question: How do plants grow?

Call to action: Planting in our garden to support insects



About this unit:

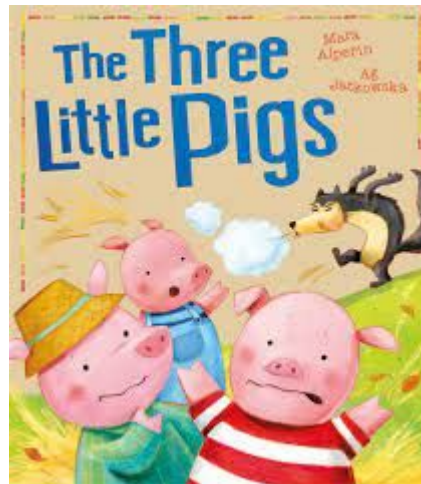
Children will be able to explore their own environment to understand the life cycle of a plant. They will plant seeds and observe the changes. They will then be able to discuss factors that can affect the plant development such as the weather and water. To enable this to happen, children will have the opportunity to, explore and experiment with various materials and resources. They will be able to use their senses for 'Hands on learning' and to identify changes.

They will take part in basic science experiments such as why the Three Little Pigs' houses blew down and think about how various forces impact on our lives as well as discuss various occupations surrounding building and creating.

Reading & Writing:

Children will be learning the text - The Three Little Pigs. We will explore the story through role play, small world play and by building houses and testing them.

Children will continue to develop their reading skills through daily RWI sessions and we will see them start to mark make and create letter or letter-like symbols.. They also have daily story sessions with teachers to help promote a love of reading.



Maths:

We will be focussing on number 0-5. We will be exploring each number in depth by comparing and composing each number. We will be finding one more and one less for these numbers and exploring

Physical Development

This term we will be exploring different ways of moving. We will also be having outdoor sessions with Mr Blacker and Mr Saunders to help further our skills in travelling over, under and around obstacles.
