Essential Question: How can I be a kind person?

Call to action: Create a book- How to be kind!



About this unit: During this unit, the children will explore what it means to be kind. They will be introduced to the schools new rules and understand what each of them means. These are to be kind, be safe and be ready! We will then move onto looking at differences between each other and understand what challenges some people may face and how they overcome these. We will think about our own challenges too. We will learn about paralympians from history who have achieved great things, regardless of the challenges they have faced.

We will use what we have learnt throughout the unit to share these ideas by creating a book about how to be kind.

Reading & Writing:

The children will be learning two texts throughout this unit. These are called 'Be Kind' and 'Look what I can do'.

Children will continue to develop their reading skills through daily RWI sessions and we will see them start to apply these skills in their writing.

The children will be practising their writing skills by writing CVC words and short sentences. They will have the opportunity during this unit to write their own short stories.

They also have daily story sessions with teachers to help promote a love of reading.

Maths: We will be learning about the composition of numbers beyond 10. We will become confident these numbers and will be able to match numerals and quantities.

We will also look at adding more using the language first, then and now. We will also be using this to help us begin to take-away.

Physical Development: Pupils will be learning about their bodies move with control whilst responding to music.
