Essential Question: How does conflict divide and unite? Call to action: Create a game that explores conflict and unity.

About this unit: In this unit children will focus on RE, PSHE, Design & Technology, Geography and History.

Children will begin by understanding how conflict has occurred in the past through The Vikings and Anglo-Saxons and recapping the Romans. They will explore the ways the Anglo-Saxons and Vikings defended themselves before learning about pulleys, levers and how to strengthen designs. They will then apply these D&T skills to design their own product to protect in times of conflict. Children will explore what type of leader Alfred and Erik were during the Viking invasion before exploring conflict that can occur online and how to keep ourselves safe online. We will finish by exploring conflict that can occur in our own lives, through exploring different games before creating our own games that explore conflict and unity.

English

In English, we will use the text, 'Women in Science' to create our own biographies about individuals who are influential to us.

We will then create our historical narratives based on 'Viking Boy'.

Maths

In maths we will continue exploring multiplication and division before learning about fractions. This will include: finding equivalent fractions, adding and subtracting fractions, looking at mixed numbers and improper fractions as well as solving word problems.





Home Learning

Speak to an adult at home about someone who they find inspiring or influential. Act like a reporter to interview the person and write up your findings. THINK: What questions will you ask the person you are interviewing? What do you want to find out? You can choose how to present your findings.

P.E; This half term the children will focus on skills such a spacial awareness, passing and teamwork in hockey.

French; Children will continue practicing how to say and write numbers as well as practicing spoken sentences.

Music; We will be exploring soul music whilst learning to read music notation and playing the glockenspiel
