Essential Question: How have I changed since a baby?


About this unit:

The children will be exploring the historical association unit 'How have I changed since I was a baby?' They will learn about the story 'Once they were giants' and explore how humans change over their life. We will go on to explore how the adults in class has changed over time and discuss and share how the children's parents have changed from the past. The children will also explore how objects and resources have changed over time and watch programmes from the past and compare how this is different from today. We will also introduce our class timeline and explore language such as today, yesterday, tomorrow, before, after.

Reading & Writing:

The children will be learning two texts which will be Little Red Riding Hood and Owl Babies. These are texts that are familiar to the children. This will include a traditional tale.

Children will continue to develop their reading skills through daily RWI sessions and we will see them start to apply these skills in their writing. The children will be practising their writing skills by writing CVC words and short sentences i.e. " using have daily story sessions with teachers to help promote a love of reading.











Maths: In maths we will be learning about the numbers 6,7 and 8. We will look at how to make up these numbers and use objects such as a tens frame, multi-link and numicon to support this. We will be exploring length and height and will also be looking at pairs. We will finally explore time and learn about different parts of the day.

Physical Development: This half term we will be practicing our perfect pencil grip and will be taking part in lots of fine motor activities to support this.

The children will also take part in weekly P.E sessions.
