Year 1 - Spring 2 2023

Literacy

We will read the book 'Dear Mother Goose'. The book shares a collection of nursery rhymes, where the characters share their problems and Mother Goose offers advice and solutions to their problems. The children will write their own reply to one of the characters and understand basic letter writing.

Maths

We will provide regular opportunities for children to verbally count to 20, for example counting how many children are present or how many bean bags there are in a bucket. Children can find counting through the teen numbers difficult. We will study how to group objects, add them to together and identify more or less using symbols and signs.

Geography


The primary objective of this enquiry is to enable pupils, as young geographers, to identify and begin to understand the key physical and human geographical features of the seaside as one.

History

This enquiry enables pupils to learn about the exploits of a range of famous explorers and to develop their knowledge of people's lives at various points in the past, ranging in extent from 16th century Europe to the 1930s in Britain and the 1960s in America.

RE

We will be discussing easter and what God means to people.



Design and Technology

The children will be learning to distinguish fruits from vegetables, and putting this knowledge into practice, handling and categorising a selection of fruits and vegetables. Finally, they will be making smoothies

Computing

The children will be learning basic computer skills such as saving files, using a mouse and developing thei keyboard skills.

Art

Children will be learning how to make 3D sculptures. They will be using their hands to manipulate a range of modelling materials, including paper and card. As well as exploring how to join and fix materials in place.
