

Year 1 - Summer 1

Maths: In Maths we will begin to move onto place value to 50. Children count forwards and backwards within 50, use number lines and build on previous learning of numbers to 20. They learn about grouping in 10s and their understanding of 1 ten being equal to 10 ones is reinforced. We will then move on to look at measuring weight and height.

Science: We will be looking at plants, trees and flowers. We will be planting our own seeds, watching them grow and then turn them into a snack/meal.

Geography: We will be looking at the weather and how it changes throughout the year and around the world. We will discuss the coldest and hottest parts of the world. We will think about what an equator is and what it means. As well as looking at explorers who have travelled in the extreme conditions.

Read, Write inc.: We will continue with our daily phonic sessions in preparation for our Phonics screening later in the year. We will continue with our daily handwriting sessions and weekly spellings.

PE: In PE we will begin to work outside on the field and enjoy the sunshine. We will start to prepare for sports day by completing track and field activities.

Music: The children will continue their weekly music lessons with Mrs Devonport.



Computing: The class will be learning how to programme a robot. As well as discuss prepositions.

PSHE: We will begin to discuss who helps us in different situations and places.

English:

We will start to look at our familiar text The Three Little Pigs. The children will begin by demonstrating their current understanding of the book by acting out characters. We will then look at the the sequence of the story and our favourite parts. Finally we will write our own version of the Three Little Pigs using verbs and descriptive language.

Art: We will begin our topic on woven wonders. We will be weaving, plaiting and threading wool, paper and thread to create our own sculptures.

D&T: We will begin to plan, make and organise our own moving story books.

History: This half term we will be investigating Pompeii and when it was hit by an extreme volcano eruption and stayed frozen in time for thousands of years.
