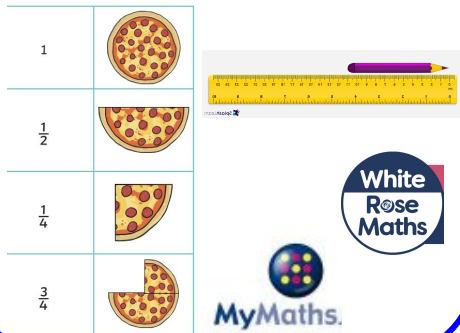


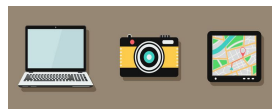
Year 2 - Summer 1

Maths:

We are going to be learning about Length and Height as well as Fractions.
