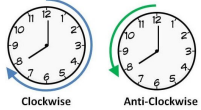


# Year 2 - Summer 2

**Maths:** This term we will be exploring Time, as well as Mass, Capacity and Temperature.

**Computing:** Children will begin to understand that sequences of commands have an outcome, and make predictions based on their learning. They will modify designs to create their own quiz questions in ScratchJr using blocks of code. Children will also evaluate their work and make improvements to their programming projects.



**English:** We will be sharing and learning a fiction text called Stuck by Oliver Jeffers. The children will then write their own story based on the pattern of the original text. Then we will experience poetry through The First Book of the Sea by Nicola Davies. The children will then write their own poem.



**Science:** Our science unit is called 'Growing up'. We will recognise the needs of a human baby for survival. Then we will compare the features of a baby and a child. After that, we will classify and recognise changes that happen as people get older. Finally we will carry out an investigation to find out whether older children have bigger heads.



**P.E.:**

The children will be learning all about striking and fielding using different equipment. This will also involve developing problem-solving skills to achieve the desired outcome. We will also be practising and preparing for Sports Day.



**Design and Technology:**

We will be designing and making a pouch using textiles. First we will learn how to use a running stitch, a template and then we will make our pouch. After that, we will use fabric glue or stitching to decorate the pouch. Finally we will evaluate our finished pouches.



**Geography:** Children will look at the world in relation to the Equator and the North and South poles. They will compare their own location with the location of Kampong Ayer in the country of Brunei within Asia. Children will explore maps of various scales and online websites to identify the time differences, traditional homes in Kampong Ayer, weather conditions, forms of transport, schools and even the structure of a typical Tropical Rainforest in Brunei.



**PSHE:** We will be learning all about health and wellbeing. First we will name and recognise different feelings and who can help us with these feelings. Then we will learn about gender stereotypes, explore differences between male and female and how this is part of a life cycle. We will look at sexual differences and name the body parts. Finally we will discuss how to manage our feelings about moving to a new class.



**R.E.:** We will be exploring what it means to belong to a faith community. We will recognise that loving others is important in lots of communities. We will be learning about traditional Jewish, Muslim and Christian welcoming and marriage ceremonies. As well as ways different people express their identity.
