

Year 3 - Autumn 1

Maths: This term we will be exploring Place Value as well as Addition and subtraction. The children will be building on their previous knowledge and start to look at numbers in the 1,000s. Children will represent and problem solve using larger quantities.

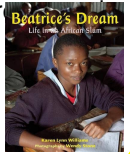


Computing: Children will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs. They will also compare digital and non-digital devices. The children will also be introduced to computer networks, including devices that make up a network infrastructure, such as wireless access points and switches. Finally, children will discover the benefits of connecting devices in a network.



Teach Computing

English: We will be looking at two texts in English this half term. Our first text will be *Beatrice's Dream*. The children will explore the text, picking out the key features before having a go at writing their own version of the text. Our second text will be *The Beasties* which is a narrative text. The children will be focussing on the use of noun phrases and will develop their independence in writing their own narrative.



Science: Our science unit is called How does your garden grow? Throughout the unit we will be looking at the different parts of flowers and their roles. We will also be exploring how water is transported through plants. We will use a range of scientific skills to support our learning.



P.E.: The children will be learning how to play team games which include Tag Rugby and Handball.



Art and Design:

In Art and Design we will be developing our drawing skills. We will be exploring the impact of shading. Children will develop this skill through observational drawings.



History: This half term, children will be learning about the Stone Age. The children will investigate what life was like during the Stone Age including how people lived and what they ate. The children will learn about the role of archaeologists and how they help us to learn about the past.

PSHE: This term we will be looking at families and relationships, we will understand how families love and support each other but also the problems that can occur. We will understand that friendships have ups and downs, as well as the impact of bullying. We will also look at the importance of communication and trust. Finally we will begin to understand the differences between people and learn to respect these differences. This will then lead onto recognising stereotypes.



R.E.: We will be exploring the Creation Story within Christianity. We will be making clear links between Genesis 1 and what Christians believe about God. We will also delve into the story of the 'Fall' and how it gives an explanation as to why things go wrong in the world. Finally we will be describing how and why Christians might pray to God and ask for forgiveness.
