

Year 5 - Autumn 1

Maths

In maths, we will start the term by exploring our understanding of place value and the size of numbers up to 1 million. After this we will look at the relationship between addition and subtraction



Science:

In science, we will expand our knowledge on life cycles of plants and animals. We will also compare the life cycles of different animal types.

Guided reading:

We will be exploring the text 'The Way Home'. We will be learning comprehension skills; retrieval, clarifying, summarising and predicting.

PE: The children will be focusing on games and how to work as a team. They will learn new skills of defending and tackling.

Music: We will be looking at composition through the topic of Egyptians.



Computing:

In this unit we will look at how computers affect our lives as well as how we can use them to benefit us. The children will learn how search engines work and how to get the results that they want.

PSHE:

We will be learning about families and relationships, identifying positive attributes about ourselves and learning what makes a good friend.

English:

In English, we are going to be writing letters that tell a story using the text 'The Day The Crayons Quit' as our inspiration. We will then be creating narratives using our model text 'The Ice Bear' focusing on using expanded noun phrases..

ART:

In our art lessons, we will be developing techniques using materials. Our theme is 'I need Space'.

RE:

The key question we will be exploring is 'What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving?'



History:

Our theme in history this half term is 'The Battle of Britain'. Children will be learning about this significant period of time, learning key dates and why the battle was significant in WW2.
