

Physical Development

We are developing our fine motors skills by using resources which develop our th muscles in our hands and through learning to form our letters using the RWi programme.

Our PE lessons with Mr Blackler and Mr Vasey will focus on exploring different ways of moving and incorporating these into games.

Literacy

We will be learning to retell the narrative Take a Walk Little Bear. The children will go on a sensory walk to retell the story and learn to orally retell the story.

Vocabulary: *cave, stream, swamp, nest*

We will then read the story of 'The Nativity'. The children will learn the text to then perform this to parents!

Vocabulary: *christmas, nativity, festive*

We will be learning lots of new vocabulary and using this when we are playing.

Understanding the World

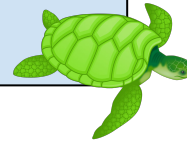
We will be exploring different .celebrations and festivals such as Bonfire Night, Diwali, Remembrance Day and Christmas.
