
Year 1/2 Autumn 2 - 2023

Science - In science, we will begin looking at different habitats that surround them.

The children will need to find a range of items outside that are living, dead and never lived.

They will be able to name a range of animals and plants that live in a habitat and microhabitats that they have studied.

We will talk about what animals eat and construct food chains to show this.









DT - During this half term the children will be making a moving monster using materials available to them in the classroom. The children will need to create levers, linkages and pivots in order for their monsters function properly.





English - During the first half of the term the children will write a narrative re-telling a popular fairytale or well-known story, the book we have chosen is *Little Red Riding Hood* by Nosy Crew.

The children will also be exploring instructions in the second half of Autumn 2.

RE - Who is a Muslim and how do they live?

The children will continue to identify some of the key Muslim beliefs and give examples of how stories about the Prophet show what Muslims believe about Mu

They will also learn about how Muslims put their beliefs about prayer into action.



Maths - We will be using the Power Maths scheme, alongside White Rose resources to teach the children.

Y1- Part-Whole within 10 Y2 - Addition and Subtraction (Part 1)

We will be using a variety of practical resources to help with our learning.

Computing - The children will be learning about IT around us, looking at photography and how to use didevices to take pictures.

PE - Every **Thursday** and **Friday**. Please can you ensure your child wears a PE Kit to school on those days. This half term the children will be learning about locomotion (running/dodging) and dance.

Music - In our weekly sessions the children will be developing their Christmas performance skills to prepare for our production.

Read Write Inc- The children will continue to have daily RWi lessons in school. The children will take home an AR/colour banded book as well as RWi book bag book to support their reading from home.

Geography -
