## **Physical Development**

We are developing our fine motor skills by using resources which develop the muscles in our hands and through learning to form our letters. Our PE lessons with Mr Blackler and Mr Vasey will focus on gymnastics and the children using movement with different body parts to make shapes.

### Understanding the World

We will be looking at People Who Help Us. We will be exploring different occupations and what their roles our within our communities.. The children will then think about what they would like to be when they grow up!

Children will be using devices to take photographs and then learning how to edit photographs.

#### Literacy

We will be reading the story 'How to Catch a Star' by Oliver Jeffers. They will learn this text and will write the beginning, middle and end of the story making their own book. The children then will move onto non-fiction writing where they will be learning about writing instructions and will write their own ideas for 'How to Catch a Star'.



# Personal, Social and Emotional

We will be focusing on turn taking activities and sharing with small groups of children.

#### Communication and Language

We will be focusing on answers how and why questions and using full sentences.

## **Expressive Art and Design**

We will be exploring colour mixing be introducing using black and white paint to change the shade of paint.

Our weekly music sessions with Mrs Devonport will involve exploring sound and tempo by using different instruments.




#### **Mathematics**
