Maths: This term we will be continuing with Multiplication and Division. Children will learn how to use the expanded method to help them solve multiplication problems and the partition method to solve division problems. Children need to be confident with their 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables. It would be helpful if children could practice these at home.

Amazing Bodies. We will revisit the importance of eating the right amounts of different types of food, whilst extending this knowledge to understand that the food we eat provides us with the nutrition that our bodies require to remain healthy. Children will also learn that humans and some other animals have skeletons and muscles for support, protection

Year 3 - Spring 2

Computing: This term our Computing unit explores the children's understanding of what a branching database is and how to create one. Children will use yes/no questions to gain an understanding of what attributes are and how to use them to sort groups of objects. Learners will create physical and on-screen branching databases. Finally they will create an identification tool using a branching database, which they will test by using it.

Geography: This half term, children will be learning about Earthquakes. Children will explore why it is that earthquakes only tend to occur in particular areas of the world as a consequence of the pattern and movement of the tectonic plates of the Earth's crust. Children will investigate the causes and impact of one specific recent earthquake in one particular location in the world, where earthquakes occur frequently, before looking more widely at global patterns.
