In computing we will focus on variables within a selection of games, we will then look to begin designing our own.

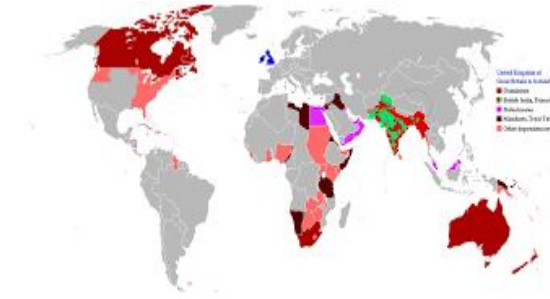


PE

Maths

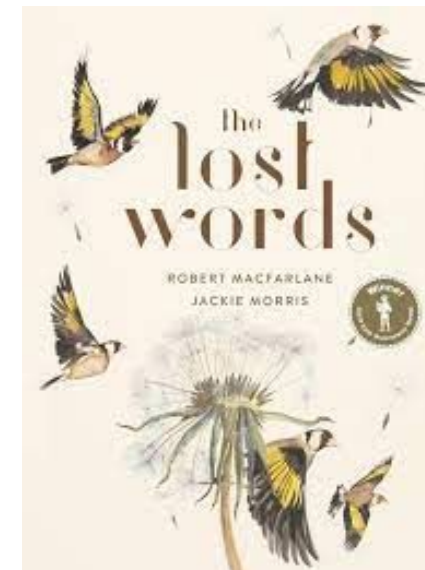
This term we will be looking at percentages and length & perimeter. We will also start to recap on prior learning though a range of different contexts.
