

Year 5 - Summer 1

Maths: We will be starting this half term by looking at rounding numbers, percentages and equivalent decimals and fractions. We will move on to looking at how to calculate the area and perimeter of 2D shapes and learn about their properties. We will also look at graphs and tables.

Science: Get sorted/Everyday materials - we will be exploring and investigating the properties of different materials.



History: We are going to look at changes of a city throughout history (Exeter). Children will learn about key events and how it has shaped the city today.



Guided reading:

We will continue to use Accelerated Reader (AR) which is matched to individual reading levels. We will also continue reading our class book (Kensuke's Kingdom) to focus on our vocabulary, inference and summarising skills.



French: Weather and the water cycle.

PE: Across Year 5, both classes have PE on a Monday and Wednesday.

Music:

The children will have a weekly music lesson with Mrs Devonport (every Wednesday).

Computing: In this unit we will start to create vector drawings. We will also learn how to use different drawing tools to help create images.



PSHE: Our key question is How can we challenge stereotypes in workplaces? The children will look at a range of careers and how to find the best role for you.



English: In English we will be using I am Cat by Jackie Morris as our stimulus. From this, we will be creating poetry. The next text type we will explore is persuasive writing in the form of a Dragon's Den style pitch.



Art: We will be exploring a range of observational drawings and using skills such as monoprinting. They will need to justify their design choices.



RE: In RE, we will be looking at what Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people.
