


Dear all.

Uniform reminders


Just a reminder that children can come into school in **school PE kit** on their class PE days (please note, football or other team kits are not allowed). As the colder weather approaches, children are welcome to wear their school jumper and plain black leggings/jogging bottoms on PE days.

Arriving to school on time

Please be reminded that the school day begins when registers open at 8:40am. Registration closes at 8:50am. Any children arriving after 8:50am will be marked as late as registers have closed at this point. For safeguarding purposes, children arriving late will have to be individually registered in the school entrance and parents will need to accompany them until they have been registered. This is to ensure that all children have been correctly registered into the building. In order to make this happen safely, parents will be asked to wait with their children outside of the main school entrance whilst children are registered in order of arrival.
